

## POSSIBLE RE-EXPRESSION OF THE LOCATIONAL STRATEGY

13<sup>th</sup> April 2011.

The spatial strategy aims to protect the Chilterns Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty<sup>1</sup> and Green Belt<sup>2</sup>. It focuses new development on land within existing settlements not covered by those designations. The built-up areas of the most accessible of these settlements, Chesham, Amersham/Amersham-on-the Hill, Chalfont St Peter and Little Chalfont will be the main focus for development between 2006 and 2026.<sup>3</sup> Limited development will take place in other villages excluded from the Green Belt, namely Chalfont St Giles; Great Missenden, Prestwood and Heath End; Holmer Green; Penn and Knotty Green; Chesham Bois and Seer Green.<sup>4</sup> Some redevelopment and infilling is planned for identified developed sites in the Green Belt.<sup>5</sup> Very little development is intended elsewhere.
