Chiltern District Council formally adopted the Core Strategy for Chiltern District on the 15<sup>th</sup> November 2011.

The Core Strategy is the Council's principal Development Plan Document and covers the whole of the Chiltern District administrative area. The Core Strategy contains planning policies which will collectively guide the location and type of all new development in the District over the period 2006 to 2026. Any person aggrieved by the Core Strategy may make an application to the High Court under section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act (2004). Any challenge must be made on the grounds that either the document has not been prepared within the powers conferred by Part 2 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 or that a procedural requirement of the act or associated regulations has not been complied with. Any such application must be made within 6 weeks of the adoption.
